2. Passing score on the 3 components of the PRAXIS1: Pre-Professional Skills Test (Reading, Writing, and Mathematics) as designated by the South Carolina Department of Education; **or**, 1650 on SAT or 24 on ACT.
3. Recommendations by one general education faculty member, your EDFS 201 instructor, and someone familiar with your work with children or youth.
4. A grade of C or better in EDFS 201 Introduction to Education.
