2. Passing score on the 3 components of the PRAXIS1: Pre-Professional Skills Test (Reading, Writing, and Mathematics) as designated by the South Carolina Department of Education; **or**, 1650 on SAT or 24 on ACT.
3. Disposition forms from one general education faculty member, your EDFS 201 instructor, and someone familiar with your work with children or youth.
4. A grade of C or better in EDFS 201 Introduction to Education.
