



Parent Follow-up on the Admissions Process

If your college-bound student plans to complete a **degree, diploma, or certificate** at TTC, this might be a useful tool to guide your child through the admission process. Admission to the College does not guarantee admission to a specific program.

Has your college-bound student...

- Completed a TTC **application** and submitted it to any TTC Admission office?
- Submitted the application **fee** (\$25) to a TTC Business office?
- Submitted to a copy of your **high school diploma** or **GED** to a TTC Admissions Office?
- Provided qualifying **SAT, ACT** or **College Placement Test scores** or submitted a **college transcript** from an accredited institution with equivalent English and/or math credits?
(If not, contact TTC Testing Services to set up a test time, 574-6410).
- Decided on a program of study **major**?
(Visit the Career Lab at any of TTC's three campuses to research careers and college majors to develop career.
- Applied for **Financial Aid** by the priority deadline?
(Check your Financial Aid status on TTC Express or in the Financial Aid office at any of our campuses.)
- Attended **Orientation** and been assigned an **academic advisor**?
(No appointment is necessary. Main Campus–Bldg 420, Palmer Campus–Rm 226, Berkeley Campus-Rm 178)
- Scheduled an **appointment** with your academic advisor to **register** for classes?
(Do not wait until Financial Aid has been approved to register for classes!)
- Checked your balance due on TTC Express and paid your **tuition** at a TTC Business office?
(Main Campus –Bldg 410/130; Palmer Campus –Rm 121; Berkeley Campus –Rm 179)
- Purchased your **books and supplies**?
(Take a copy of your class schedule when you go to the Bookstore) with you when you go to the bookstore?
- Obtained your TTC **Student ID card** through Student Activities?
(Main Campus – 410/130, Palmer Campus – Rm 121, Berkeley Campus- Rm 179)
- Picked up a **parking decal** through the Business Office at an of the three campuses?

USEFUL TIPS

- Be aware of important dates such as Drop/Ad, Financial Aid priority dates, etc. Look in the TTC Student Handbook, On Course, or on the TTC website
- Arrive early for class. Give yourself time to find a parking space and your classroom.
- Remember to check Campus Cruiser for current TTC information as well as your TTC email account.
