To be reviewed for residency appeal, students must prove dependence or independence. Dependent students' residency for tuition purposes is the same as parent/guardian who lists student as a dependent or has custody of student. Students under 24 years of age who are NOT claimed as dependent on parent/guardian's tax returns may qualify for local residency for tuition purposes by proving independent status. In addition to other documents, students requesting independent status must provide:

Affidavit of Financial Independence showing student provided more than half of his/her financial support during the 12 months immediately prior to date classes begin

Proof of most recent income and, if needed, prior income during last twelve months

Student's tax returns showing independent status Year

Affidavit to provide tax returns Year

Parent/Guardian's tax returns showing student is/was not/will not be claimed as dependent Year

Affidavit to provide tax returns Year

South Carolina Driver's License OR South Carolina Identification Card

South Carolina Motor Vehicle Registration

South Carolina Voter Registration

South Carolina Tax Return

Letter from employer on letterhead or equivalent stating dates of full-time employment (at least 37.5 hours per week). If you do not work 37.5 hours per week but are eligible for full-time benefits, letter should so state.

This letter should be signed by human resources or your supervisor and include a telephone number for this person.

Applicant must be domiciled in the State of South Carolina for twelve (12) months immediately prior to enrolling to be considered for in-state tuition and in Berkeley, Charleston or Dorchester County for in-county and have possession of documents that the Statutory Authority: 1976 Code Sections 59-112 through 59-112-100 S. C. Code of Law requires.
