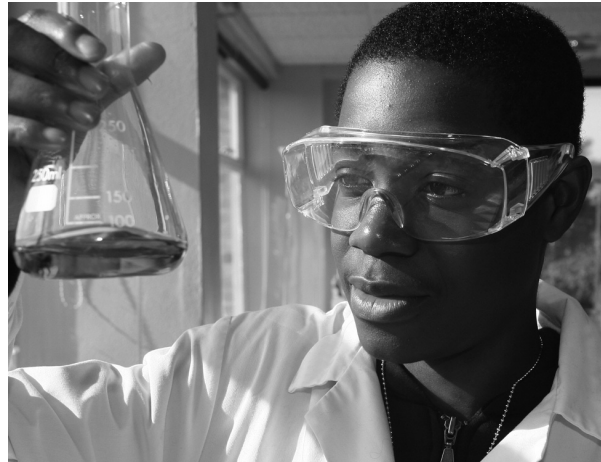


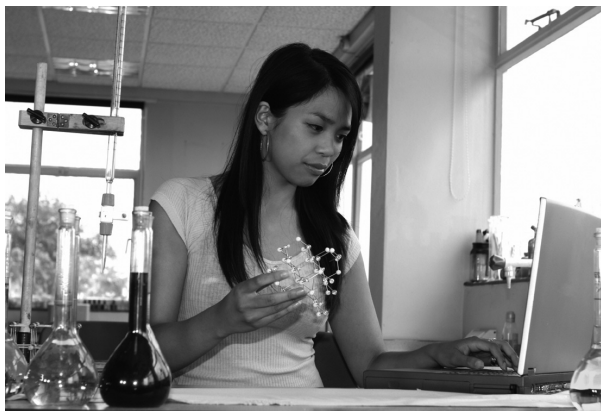
## What is the goal of the Upward Bound Math and Science Center (UBMSC)?

UBMSC encourages its participants to complete secondary school and enroll in postsecondary educational programs in math- or science-related fields. Our program helps students acquire skills and knowledge that increase the likelihood that they will enter a college or university and successfully complete an undergraduate program of study.



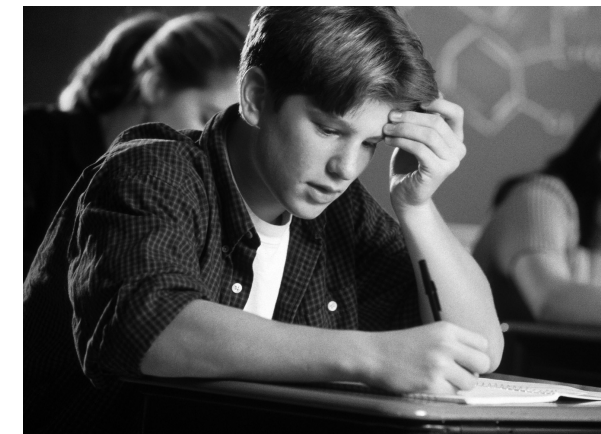
## What does UBMSC provide?

- A six-week Discovery Summer program focusing on math and science
- Nine Discovery Saturday sessions during the fall and spring semesters
- Counseling for each student including academic advising, career counseling and personal development/planning
- Free transportation to and from TTC's Berkeley Campus, breakfast and lunch, and a weekly stipend
- Assistance applying to colleges and universities, including help with two-year versus four-year admission requirements
- Activities involving interaction with individuals employed in a field that may interest each student



- Educational and cultural field trips, including college tours in South Carolina, North Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Tennessee, Louisiana, and Washington, D.C.
- Tutoring and college/career advising throughout the academic year, including study skills training, SAT/ACT preparation, college planning and college survival skills
- Information on colleges and universities with math and science degree programs
- Participation in the BRIDGE program to earn college credits
- Opportunities to develop leadership, communication and decision-making skills and community service
- Fee waivers for SAT, ACT and college application fees (must meet income guidelines)
- Access to online college resources
- Scholarship searches and scholarships
- Guidance with the financial aid process
- Dual-credit classes

## BRIDGE Program



Upon graduating from high school you are eligible for the BRIDGE component. Under the BRIDGE program, you can take two courses at Trident Technical College during the summer following your high school graduation and UBMSC will pay your tuition, buy your books and supplies, and give you a weekly stipend. Credit hours earned may be transferred to the college of your choice.

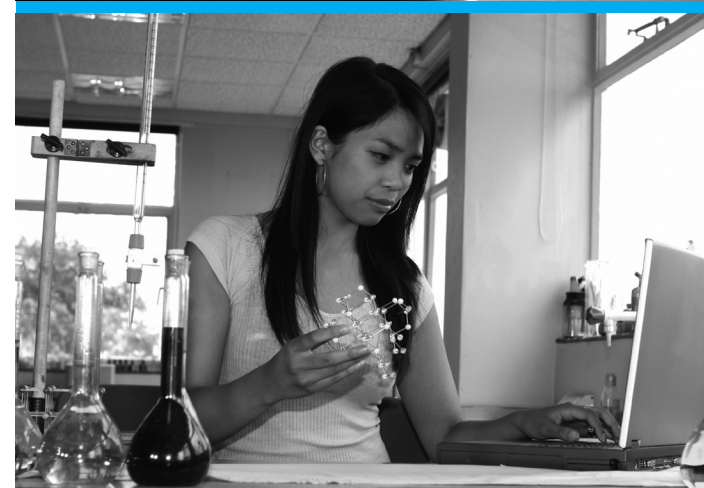
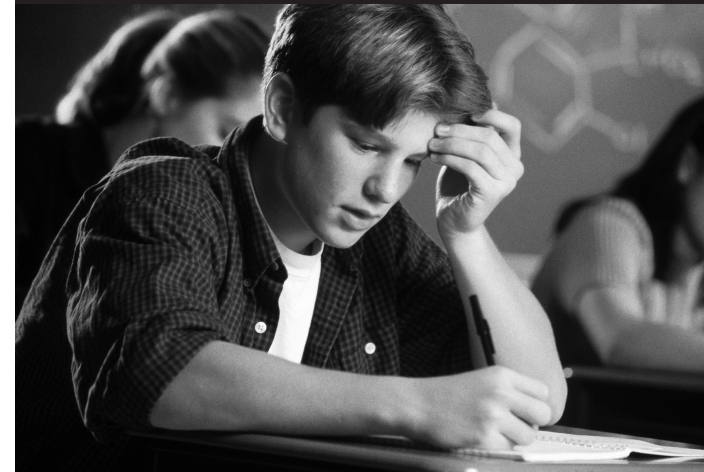
