High school students who provide **all qualifying test scores** (verbal and math) may be accepted provisionally for one term into one of TTC's 150+ programs of study. These students submit TTC's traditional application (online or paper) and provide completed high school transcript or copy of diploma after graduation. Current or former Early Admit or Dual Credit students submit the Student Information Update.

As these early graduates provisionally accepted in traditional programs are no longer counted as high school students, they also are no longer eligible for lottery funding unless they have a completed FAFSA on file with the Department of Education prior to the Financial Aid Priority Date for spring, usually mid-fall. Completed means submission and approval of additional information requested or resolution of audit, if selected, so students and parents should begin the FAFSA process very early in the school year. Students who miss the published priority date must be prepared to pay tuition and other costs and be reimbursed, if eligible, when financial aid is processed. Some students may qualify for aid greater than lottery funding.

Early graduates still included as high school students by their schools who are enrolling in their first TTC courses submit the Early Admit application. Current or former Early Admit or Dual Credit students submit the Early Admit Update. These Early Admit students do not complete FAFSA for this term, but should submit FAFSA for the first term after high school graduation.

All TTC students must provide qualifying test scores or pre-requisites for each course prior to enrolling.
