

Youth Apprenticeship Application Packet Checklist

A complete application packet must include the following:

√ Youth Apprenticeship Application Form

PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY!

- ✓ A cover letter, which should address the following questions: (see sample)
 - a. Why do you want to be a youth apprentice?
 - b. How do your career interests relate to the apprenticeship for which you are applying?
 - c. Why do you think you should be hired as a youth apprenticeship?
- ✓ A résumé, which includes: (see sample)
 - a. Education (include any courses/training that support your qualifications and interest in a youth apprenticeship)
 - b. Awards and honors
 - c. Extracurricular activities
 - d. Any employment information
 - e. Volunteer work/community service
 - f. Interests and skills

✓ Two recommendation forms

Recommendations should come from:

- a. Within a school setting (teacher, coach, school counselor)
- b. An individual in the community (volunteer coordinator, youth director, employer)
- c. A relative is acceptable **only** if he or she has supervised you in a paid work setting.
- ✓ Release of Information Form
- ✓ Media Consent and Release Form
- ✓ Qualifying Placement Test Scores and any other required testing for apprenticeship

Youth Apprenticeship Applicant Requirements

ALL PATHWAYS

- Applicants must be attending a public/private/charter/online high school in the tri-county region (Berkeley/Charleston/ Dorchester counties) and be eligible to legally work in the U.S. and receive post-secondary education.
- o Pre-Nursing (PCT) is the only pathway with a deadline of May 1st.
- Students are encouraged to apply as early as possible in the hiring cycle as some pathways can be competitive with a limited number of positions.
- o Completion of an application does not guarantee entrance into the CRYA program. Applicants must be interviewed and hired by an employer partner to become youth apprentices.
- o The hiring cycle runs from the end of January to early July.

• CNA to Pre-Nursing (LTC)

Construction

- o No academic placement required.
- Applicants must be able to work Monday-Friday, at least 30 hours a week, during the academic year.

Cybersecurity

o Applicants must be 18 to apply for this pathway

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

- o Applicants must turn 18 by April 1st of the following year
- o Ex. Applicant applies in 2025, they must be 18 by 4/1/26

HVAC

 Applicants must be able to work at least two full days per week, Monday-Friday, during the academic year.

Medical Office Assistant

o This is an administrative role; no hands-on patient care.

• PLTW Engineering Technician/Assistant

 Applicants must have taken or be scheduled to take PLTW Principles of Engineering and PLTW Introduction to Engineering.

• Pre-Nursing (PCT) - Deadline for Applications is May 1st.

CNA to Pre-Nursing (LTC) and Pre-Nursing (PCT) Youth Apprenticeship Applicant Requirements

ALL PATHWAYS

 Applicants must be attending a public/private/charter/online high school in the tri-county region (Berkeley/Charleston/ Dorchester counties) and be eligible to legally work in the U.S. and receive post-secondary education.

CNA to Pre-Nursing (LTC)

- Applicants must be 16 years old before CNA training starts on June 12.
- o Interviews will be for long-term care facilities only (primarily in Berkeley and Dorchester Counties).
- o Must pass state CNA exam administered by SC Nurse Aid Registry to remain employed.

• Pre-Nursing (PCT)

- o Deadline for Applications is May 1st. Students must have fully completed applications with qualifying English and Math placement.
- o Applicants must be 16 years old before CNA training starts on June 12.
- o Interviews will be with hospitals that may include locations in downtown Charleston.

Both CNA to Pre-Nursing (LTC) and Pre-Nursing (PCT) Requirements Upon Hiring:

- Students must show proof of medical insurance.
- Students must show proof of a basic physical examination or health assessment that is less than one year from the first day of class.
- Students must show proof of hepatitis B vaccination or waiver. These results can be pulled from DHEC website.
- Student must provide a copy of a picture I.D. (Ex: State I.D., Passport, School I.D.).
- Student must provide proof of Covid vaccination or waiver. A minimum of one vaccination is required.
- The items listed above are not covered under tuition.
