

What is the goal of the Upward Bound Math and Science Center?

UBMSC encourages its participants to complete secondary school and enroll in postsecondary educational programs in math- or science-related fields. Our program helps students acquire skills and knowledge that increase the likelihood that they will enter a college or university and successfully complete an undergraduate program of study.

Rigorous Curriculum Support Program

As a program participant, we encourage all program students to engage in the most rigorous curriculum of study available within their select schools. In consideration of the student's highest level of aptitude evidenced by test scores, grades and other school or program administered assessments, students are guided by target school and program school counseling professionals. Rigorous courses include AP, IB and dual credit courses at Trident Technical College. Upward Bound will provide participants with instructional tutoring, access to books and academic supplies at no cost to students.



What does UBMSC provide?

- A six-week Discovery Summer program focusing on math and science offered both in person and virtually
- Nine Discovery Saturday sessions during the fall and spring semesters offered both in person and virtually
- Counseling for each student including academic advising, career counseling and personal development/planning
- Free transportation to and from TTC's Berkeley Campus, breakfast and lunch, and a weekly stipend
- Assistance applying to colleges and universities, including help with two-year versus four-year admission requirements
- Activities involving interaction with individuals employed in a field that may interest each student
- Educational and cultural field trips, including college tours in South Carolina, North Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Tennessee, Louisiana, Washington, D.C. and other states throughout the nation
- Tutoring and college/career advising throughout the academic year, including study skills training, SAT/ACT preparation, college planning and college survival skills
- Information on colleges and universities with math and science degree programs
- Participation in the BRIDGE program to earn college credits
- Opportunities to develop leadership, communication and decision-making skills, and participate in community service.
- Fee waivers for SAT, ACT and college application fees (must meet income guidelines)
- Access to online college resources
- Scholarship searches, application and academic resume development
- Guidance on dual-credit enrollment classes

UBMSC Resource Center

The UBMSC Resource Room is located at TTC's Berkeley Campus in Moncks Corner. It's free and open to the UBMSC participants and their parents, as well as target school guidance staff. The Resource Center houses the latest career/college tools and information, career surveys, college videos/viewbooks and access to the Internet.

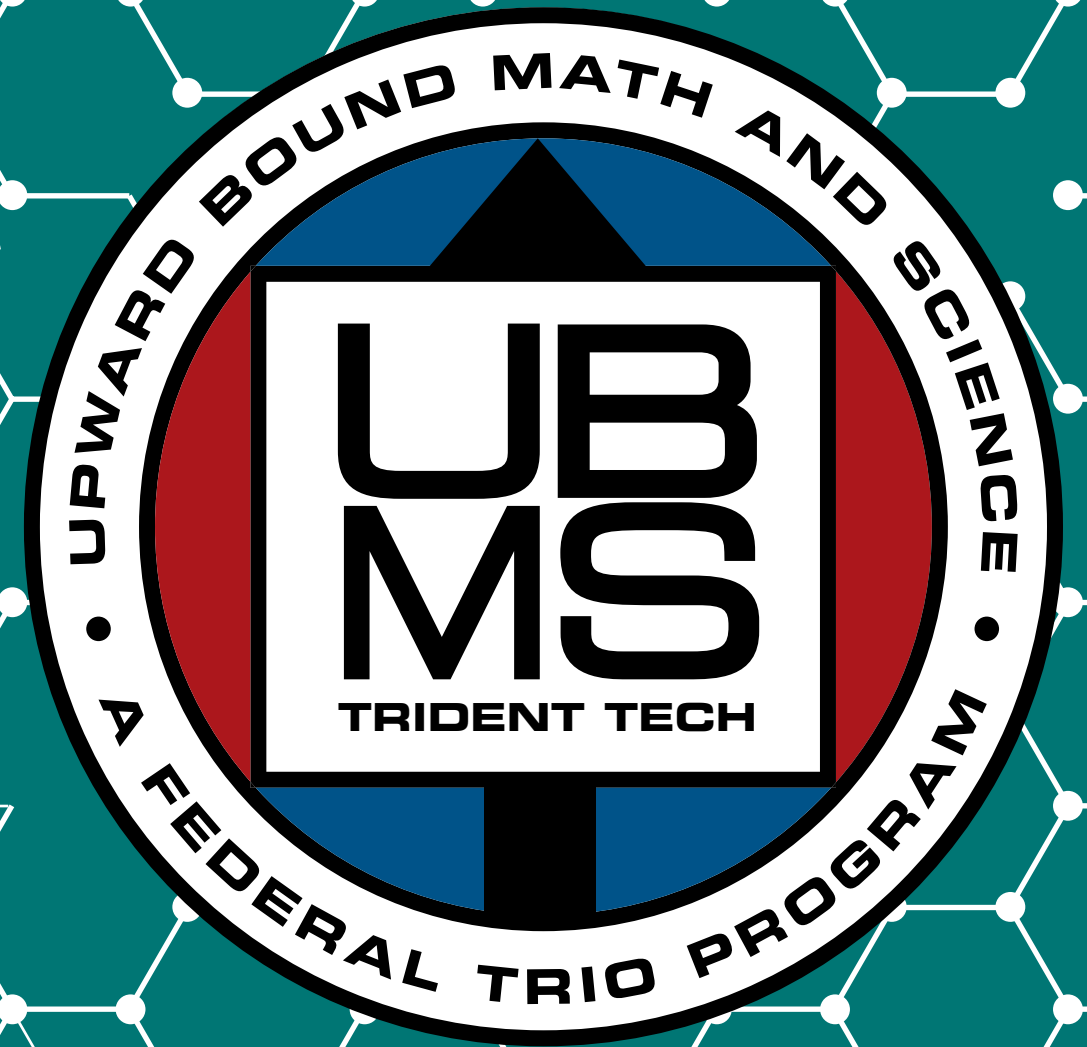
