Free tuition for all programs thru Spring '24

Most South Carolina residents attending Trident Technical College are eligible for free tuition* thru Spring Semester 2024. Multiple state programs are available to provide no-cost or reduced tuition.

Take these easy steps:

1. Apply for admission to the college. Create an Apply Now account at www.tridenttech.edu and complete the free online college admission application if you are a new student or if you have not been enrolled during the last three semesters.

2. Choose your major from 10 areas of interest.

- Business
- Culinary and Hospitality
- Education
- Engineering and Manufacturing
- Health, Human and Personal Services
- Information Technology
- Law and Criminal Justice
- Maintenance and Technical Trades
- Media and Visual Arts
- University Transfer

3. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov. Submit the 2022-2023 FAFSA to start now through Summer Semester 2023. Submit the 2023-2024 FAFSA to start Fall Semester 2023 or Spring Semester 2024. For FAFSA help, call 843-722-5509 or 843-574-6430 or email eoc@tridenttech.edu.

4. Register for classes. There is no minimum credit requirement. For help selecting classes in your major and to reach your career goals, see your assigned advisor or a navigator in The Hub. See <https://bit.ly/StartatHub>.

Exceptions: Free tuition is available to S.C. residents with three exceptions: dual credit students, students in default on federal loans, and DACA students.

*TTC will apply any federal and state grants and scholarships for which you are eligible (for example: Pell, S.C. lottery-funded tuition assistance, etc.). The college will waive any remaining tuition, registration and course fees. Depending on financial aid package, some students may receive money for books, digital course materials, fees and supplies. Requirements for free tuition vary based on the state programs awarded. You will receive information on any requirements once awarded. Out-of-state students majoring in one of the free tuition programs will be provided a fee reduction equal to the out-of-county rate.
