OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT

Applicant instructions: Students must document a minimum of 40 hours of observation in occupational therapy. While all 40 hours may be completed in one facility, it is preferred that the observation hours be divided between hospital and nonhospital facilities. However, a minimum of 20 hours must be performed in one of the following facilities: skilled nursing facility, inpatient rehabilitation facility, or an acute hospital facility. Applicants are responsible for seeking out and scheduling their own observation hours experiences.
