**Question 1:** Page 16, Water Treatment, Service levels, A. States visits will be 2/month. Page 34, Quotation Schedule, Item 1. States visits will be 2/week. What is visit schedule for first 2 months?

**State's response:** Change. The correct number of visits for the first two months is 2 per month, not 2 per week. The Quotation Schedule has been amended to reflect this change and amended quotation schedule titled, "QUOTATION SCHEDULE – Amendment 1" is included in this amendment below.

**Question 2:** (Solicitation Page 16) Trident Technical College is soliciting bids for full chemical testing, treatment, inspection, maintenance, and consultation service for HVAC water systems of the college.
