Title: Replace Refrigeration Condensers on TTC Palmer Campus

Is hereby amended as follows:

#### **Answers to questions received:**

- Q-1: Are all (4) circuits currently utilizing R404A or do any of the circuits need to be converted from another refrigerant (R-22)?
- A-1: State's response: No change. Not all of the units are utilizing R404A. The unit supporting the walk-in cooler is using a refrigerant that pre-dates R404A. Contractor shall convert all units to R404A refrigerant.
- Q-2: Will the existing line sets be reused or need to be replaced?
- A-2: State's response: No change. Yes. All existing line sets will be re-used as much as is practicable to do so and shall be sealed and encased in a small curb.
- Q-3: Will the existing TXV's on each evaporator be reused or need to be replaced?
- A-3: State's response: No change. Contractor shall replace existing TXV's.
- Q-4: Because the dimensions of the existing curb will not accommodate more than (3) of the new units specified, can the larger unit be set on 4" X 4" pressure treated lumber directly on the roof adjacent to the existing curb?
- A-4: State's response: Change. Yes. The larger unit can be placed on a 4' X 4' pressure treated limber pad directly on the roof adjacent to the existing curb.

- Q-5: Can existing refrigerant charge (R404A) be reused to charge new systems or can only new refrigerant be used to do so?
- A-5: State's response: No change. No. Only new refrigerant shall be used.
