Changes related to questions:

- **Q-1:** Do you only want a bid/quote submitted on a head count of 648? If that number changes for the fall of '22 plus the spring of '23 plus the summer of '23, do you understand that an endorsement on the policy for the actual head count must be used to correct the student participation head count for this policy that is being bid up or down?
- **A-1: States Response. No Change.** The 648 is the actual numbers as of this date. For quoting purposes use 1,581 which is TTC's 2019 pre-pandemic number shown on the attached list. TTC anticipates returning to the pre-pandemic number.

Q-2: Are the organizations & clubs operating at all 6 locations specified on page 16 of the bid?

A-2: States Response. No Change. No, student organizations & clubs are only present and operating on three campuses (Thornley, Berkeley, and Palmer Campuses).
