Description of the Agency need that this procurement meets: Trident Technical College's (TTC) Industrial Maintenance program for Mechanical, Electrical, Hydraulic and Pneumatic training requires additional equipment to accommodate the increasing growth and demand. The purchase of the sensors and teaching curriculum listed below will provide TTC with a SMART LAB which will allow TTC to teach AI type monitoring and repairs. TTC's students will gain hands on experience with some of the latest technology that also meets our local industry's standards and requirements.

Description of market research Agency performed to determine the availability of products or services that would meet the Agency's needs: The end user searched online for sensors that would give TTC the capability to teach AI fundamentals and that would also integrate with the Industry 4.0 training unit that TTC currently uses for instruction in the program. He could not find any other products that would both meet the instructional requirement and integrate with the current equipment.

Description of supplies, construction, information technology, and/or services Vendor will provide under the contract: TTC will purchase seven (7) TP-1311 Sensors/TP-1312 Smart Sensors to include magnetic proximity sensors, inductive proximity sensors, optical proximity sensors, capacitive proximity sensors, inductive sensors (analogue), smart sensors equipped with IO-Link, photoelectric sensor, inductive proximity sensor, ultrasonic sensor, and the curriculum campus license.

Detailed explanation why no other vendor's supplies, construction, information technology, and/or services will meet the needs of the Agency: These sensors are sold as a kit and have the capability to connect the Industry 4.0 training unit that is currently used for training in the existing lab. Carolina Training Associates is the only vendor authorized to sell this FESTO equipment to us.
