Student Support Services

As a TTC student, you can find the academic resources you need to succeed in your courses, quiet spaces to complete your studies, food services to fuel your day and engaging student activities around each campus. Make the most of your time at the college with the resources below.

Student Health and Wellness

TTC promotes each student's well-being with services that support physical, nutritional and mental wellness.

<u>Dining Services</u> are available for students to easily grab a bite to eat, including The Bistro, TTC Café, Grab-N-Go Market Places and vending machines.

The TTC Grocery Vault allows students to focus on their studies without sacrificing their nutritional needs or worrying about their financial standing.

The InterTech Group Wellness Center is a free fitness center for current students.

Public Safety is present on every campus, ensuring every student's safety.

Personal Counseling is here for students to help deal with an immediate concern.

Study Rooms are available at the TTC libraries for individual and group study sessions.

The <u>Cosmetology</u> and <u>Dental Clinics</u> are open to the public with services performed by current TTC Cosmetology and Dental Hygiene students. Clinics are located on campus. Services, prices, clinic details and appointment information are available on the respective program pages.

Getting Connected at TTC

Despite being a commuter college, social events and opportunities occur on each campus throughout the year for students to participate in and socialize.

TTC Campuses have many locations for students to convene, including student lounge areas, centers and study rooms, dining spaces, galleries and more.

<u>Student Life</u> offers opportunities for students to get involved in the college, develop social and professional skills, and participate in fun events and activities, such as student organizations, student cabinet, student ambassadorship, campus events, Student Life periods and career services.

<u>TTC Alumni and Friends</u> network provides opportunities for former students who have successfully completed courses to stay connected to the college and participate in mutually beneficial activities and initiatives.

<u>Travel and Study Abroad Opportunities</u> are encouraged for students to take advantage of and are available to students over the age of eighteen. Many TTC trips are credit-bearing and program-specific.

Academic Support and Advising

At TTC, you can find help throughout your entire academic journey, from enrollment to graduation, to get the most out of college and ensure your success in the future.

<u>The Student Success Center</u> is a one-stop shop for assistance from orientation through enrollment and general help.

<u>The Registrar's Office</u> offers help with the registration process, evaluation and award of transfer credits, course substitutions, program of study changes, and applying for graduation.

<u>Academic Advising</u> helps determine how courses fit into your academic schedule and how to best use your resources to accomplish your academic goals.

<u>Academic Counseling</u> helps undecided students or students uncertain of their program of study decide or reassure what academic path they want to take. Counselors can also help with developing college and academic skills.

<u>The Services for Students with Disabilities Office</u> serves students with documented learning, physical, health and psychiatric disabilities with services and academic accommodations.

Learning Resources

Learning resources are available in person and online to help all TTC students with their studies and academic success.

<u>Tutoring</u> services are offered at <u>Thornley</u>, <u>Berkeley</u>, <u>Mount Pleasant</u> and <u>Palmer Campus</u>, and <u>at home</u>. The library also provides <u>guides</u> on a variety of subjects and programs.

<u>The TTC library</u> supports all programs of study and informational needs of the college, on and off campus. Students, faculty and staff have access to all items in the library's collection, research resources and library services in-person and online. TTC's libraries are on the Thornley, Palmer and Berkeley campuses.

<u>The Student Success Center</u> is a one-stop shop for students who are looking for general help, orientation information, receiving a success coach or advisor and making referrals as needed.

The Student Resource Center assists with D2L, access to Microsoft Office 365, MyITLab, preparing for online classes, scholarship and transfer assistance and technology learning sessions.

The TTC Bookstore sells the textbooks and supplies you need at the college.

The TTC Student Portal is the home for academic, campus and student resources every student needs. Students can customize their dashboard with information relevant to them.

Career Services

Get prepared for a career before finishing college. TTC offers plenty of resources to discover your career path, find and prepare for a job and gain the necessary skills.

<u>The Student Employment Center</u> offers guidance on creating a resume, searching for a job and preparing for the interview process.

Career Counseling helps students find a career path that is meaningful to them.

<u>The Federal Work-Study Program</u> is a part-time employment program for eligible students to work on or off campus while attending school, offering work experience, job opportunities and employment earnings.
