

TRIDENT TECHNICAL COLLEGE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES



IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN APPLYING FOR A SCHOLARSHIP:

- You must be enrolled in a degree, certificate or diploma program and have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0.
- Apply online Jan 13 - June 6, 2025 for the upcoming 2025-2026 academic year.
- To be considered for a scholarship on the basis of financial need, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and supply all necessary documentation to the Financial Aid office prior to the June 6 scholarship deadline.

All students are encouraged to complete the FAFSA to make sure they are considered for all eligible scholarships and available public aid.

APPLICATION PROCESS

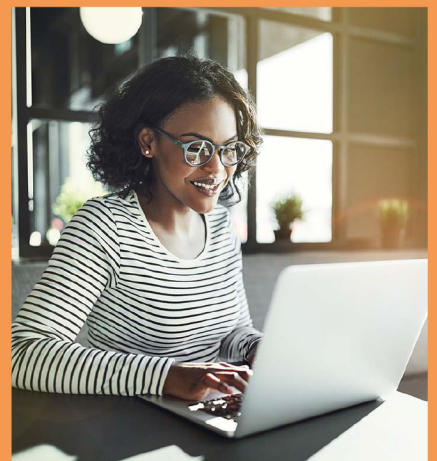
To be considered for TTC Foundation scholarships for the 2025-26 academic year, answer "Yes" to the first question in Part 1 of the online application. Selecting "Yes" means you will be considered for all TTC Foundation scholarships for which you are eligible; however, it does not guarantee that you will receive a scholarship. There is an optional Part 2 for more specific scholarships and an optional Part 3 for the scholarships that require essays.

Please note:

- Applicants submit ONE application per cycle.
- Scholarships awarded through the Foundation are only for use at Trident Technical College.
- All scholarships are competitive and are based on criteria established by donors.
- Most scholarships do NOT require an essay. However, please review all essay questions in Part 3 of the online application.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Foundation scholarships are awarded based on the eligibility criteria established by the donor, which may include: demonstrated financial need, academic information (GPA, active program of study, credit hours completed, etc.), community service and essay submission.
- For scholarships requiring an essay, they are scored numerically based on content, grammar, spelling and punctuation. Each essay is scored by three reviewers and scores are averaged.
- Applications are evaluated by scholarship selection committees comprised of Trident Tech faculty & staff and TTC Foundation Trustees.
- Applicants are notified of their award status via my.tridenttech.edu email in August.
