High School Seniors Apply online for scholarships

Complete TTC's online scholarship application between Jan. 16 and March 2, 2018. The college will use your application to determine your eligibility for **all** TTC scholarships for the 2018-19 academic year.

Before gaining access to the online scholarship application, high school seniors must complete these steps:

- 1) Submit a TTC admission application to the TTC Admissions office. *You will receive a TTC student ID number and email account once your application is processed.*
- 2) Submit an official high school transcript (through your junior year) to the Admissions office.
- 3) Submit SAT/ACT scores to the Admissions office OR complete the TTC placement test.

Once you complete these steps you may access the online scholarship application through the my.tridenttech.edu student portal.

From the main menu, click on “Financial Life,” then “My Financial Aid,” and then “2018-19 TTC Online Scholarship Application,” under “Financial Aid Announcements.”

Part 1 - Confirm that you want to apply for scholarships by answering “yes” to the first question. Verify your contact information and high school/college transcript information. Completing this section allows the college to determine your eligibility for scholarship opportunities that are based on program of study, GPA, enrollment and financial need.

Part 2 (optional*) - Provide additional information by answering a series of “yes/no” questions and listing community service experiences that are required by some scholarship opportunities.

Part 3 (optional*) - Review additional scholarship opportunities that require an essay and select the scholarship essays (if any) you would like to submit. Instructions for completing your selected essays will be sent to your my.tridenttech.edu email account.

*Complete these sections to help the college evaluate your application for more scholarship opportunities.

Some TTC scholarship opportunities are based on financial need. The college encourages all students to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov by March 2, 2018.
